Recognizing that students' learning significantly improves when they receive feedback on their academic work in a timely manner, teachers return graded work on the following time line:

Types of Assignments	Number of Class Periods after Students Turned in the Assignment:
<i>Daily work</i> – For instance: assignments, homework questions, folders, binders, notebooks, journals, problems of the week, quizzes, tests (primarily short answer), class skits, discussion groups, labs, workbooks, paragraph assignments, guided reading, literature circles, small projects etc.	2 class periods*
<i>Larger tasks</i> – For instance: essay tests, quarterly notebooks or journals, group presentations, large projects	1 week
<i>Major projects</i> – Eighth grade and senior research papers	2 weeks

*If an assignment is turned in on Monday for a class that next meets on Tuesday and Thursday, the graded work should be returned by Thursday.
